Important Dates

In addition to the practice dates, which will be determined by the Dance Director, attendance at all of the activities relating to the fashion show is MANDATORY. An absence is grounds for dismissal from the show, as is any violation of the conditions stated in the Dancer Contract.

Dancer Contract

In order for the show to be a complete success, it is important that you understand the requirements and expectations of participating. Please <u>click here</u> to complete the Dancer Contract and submit your participation fee **by January 31, 2013**:

- **Dancer Contract:** Each dancer must read and acknowledge this outline of responsibilities and other important information. By completing this form, you are confirming that you are able to participate in all mandatory activities and you have the support of your parents.
- Participant Fee: We are asking each dancer to pay a \$25.00 fee which covers the cost of a photograph in the program, food at the rehearsal and between shows.  - * A \$0.50 convenience fee is added for processing payments online.

Grand Finale - Senior Dancers only

As a senior in the show, you have the privilege of walking in the Grand Finale of the Dinner Show escorted by your father. If your father is not available, then your mother or other significant family member may escort you. The Dance Contract asks you to specify your escort, so it's helpful to know who you would like to escort you before you complete the on-line contract.

• <u>Formal Dress Guidelines</u> (same guidelines as the school has for prom dresses): Dresses should be tasteful and sophisticated. There should be no bare stomachs, cutouts on the stomach or sides. There may be no visible tattoos. The backless area on the dress may extend no lower than the waist. Low cut dresses in the front are not acceptable and no see through dresses. Spaghetti straps and strapless are ok.

Dress approvals will take place on Wednesday, March 13th.
